COMPETITOR INFORMATION

The National Championship is **OPEN ENTRY**. Competitors may enter as many bikes as they wish. There is no entry fee.

Entries will only be guaranteed up to and including 10th May 2019. Any entry submitted after this date is accepted solely at the organiser's discretion.

Judging is by a selected panel of "professional" builders and VIP invited guests. Judging will take place on Saturday 15th June for the main awards ceremony which will take place at KICKBACK at 2:00pm on Sunday 16th June 2019.

The National Championships operates a bike runner program to show that all competing bikes actually run! We request either a video of your bike entry running prior to the expo or perform a run test at Prescott on Saturday 15th June at the time of your delivery. There is a space for you to run your bikes at Prescott.

National Championships Custom Bike Category Definitions

You may enter your bike(s) into the following classes. If you have any queries about whether your bike is eligible for a particular class, then please contact us. One bike into one class.

FREESTYLE

Any bike, any style, any way you want. Unlimited imagination and craftsmanship meets engineering and design excellence. Ground up build, open to all pro-builders and non-professionals. ONLY RULE - There are NO rules!

YOUNG BUILDER

This category is open to all custom bike builders under 30 years of age on 16th June 2019. This class is open to all non-professional builders as well as professional builders and part-time pro-builders. You can build and enter any style of custom bike from freestyle, chopper style, café racer, tracker, streetfighter, brat, digger, bobber, dragster, etc etc.

MODIFIED (“BUTCHERED”) CLASSIC

Open to all modified classics: whether customised with wider wheels, 'spangly' paint, different engines or just a braced swingarm, all are welcome. All bike entries must be registered 1990 or earlier. With whatever modification you feel makes it special to you. Fitting a Bandit engine into a Z1 frame for instance!

BEST BUDGET BUILD

This class is for the very best customised motorcycle built on a tight budget. All styles encouraged including café racer, chopper, bobber, flat tracker, scrambler, streetfighter etc etc... Total build spend must not exceed £3000 including the donor bike and parts.

MODIFIED PERFORMANCE SPORTSBIKE

Any make and style of modern (post 1990) custom-engineered sports / street bike. We encourage “power adders” such as turbos, Nos, superchargers, big bores, suspension, braking and enhanced styling including naked, fairings, paint, metalwork etc. Using standard or special frames, i.e. Spondon, Harris, GIA etc. Improved speed, handling and performance.

Terms & Conditions of Entry

Completion of the Official Entry Form is essential. No participation will be permitted without it.

REGISTRATION

Bikes must be delivered and presented at Devitt KICKBACK Prescott between 11am and 7pm on Friday 15th June 2019 or between 8am and 11.30am on Saturday 15th June. Bikes arriving outside these times without prior arrangement with the organisers may be refused entry. All entries will be issued with the appropriate people and 4 wheel vehicle passes to gain entry to the showground. No passes – no entry – no exceptions. All arrivals use the Main Entrance.

On arrival you will be directed to the Orchard Camping Area. You should then move your motorcycle to your dedicated space in the Kickback marquee area, marshals will be on hand to guide you. Your motorcycle should then remain in the marquee until breakdown on Sunday.

Vehicles in the Orchard may enter / leave through the Bottom Gate should you need to go off site. Please drive slowly and carefully and follow the marshals instructions.

Note there is no vehicle movement during public opening times.

WORKING ORDER

All bikes must be capable of starting and running. Entrants will be required to prove that they are 'runners' in order to claim an award, by submitting video evidence in advance of the event, or must complete a live run test at Prescott upon arrival.

BIKE DISPLAYS

All entrants will be required to provide a brief technical specification of their entered bike(s) in advance of the event date, which will be used on the A4 display placard identifying their bike. Bikes must remain in place at all times until the event closes at 5pm on Sunday 15th June. There are no exceptions to this rule.

NUMBER OF BIKES

The organisers reserve the right to set a limit on the number of bikes any single builder may enter. Please discuss with us in advance, and indicate planned number on the Official Entry Form.

ACCEPTANCE OF RULES

Participation in the event will constitute acceptance of these and all or any other rules or regulations pertaining to participation in and operation of the event.

DIRECTIONS TO PRESCOTT HILL CLIMB (GL52 9RD)

From Cheltenham - Take the A435 North towards Evesham. 1 mile north of Bishops Cleeve turn right to Gotherington. Straight on through village and the Hill Climb is 1 mile on the right.

From M5 Junc 9 - Take A46 East signed Evesham. In 3 miles at roundabout take 4th exit signed A435 Cheltenham. In 3 miles turn left signed Gotherington, then as above.

There will be several marshals in the road near the entrance to direct you. Please follow their instructions.

COSTS, LIABILITIES AND INSURANCE

All costs connected with bikes appearing at, and being removed from, the National Championships are entirely the responsibility of the entrant. ShowCo and KICKBACK organisers shall be held harmless and do not accept any liabilities whatsoever, howsoever caused, arising from weather, acts of God and/or participation in the event. Participation is entirely at the builder's own risk in all respects.

The organisers will, of course, take the steps that it deems appropriate or reasonable to ensure the safety and security of the motorcycle(s) concerned, but can in no way accept any kind of liability for any loss or damage arising, of any kind whatsoever.

All liabilities and insurances are the responsibility of the competitor in all respects. All other liabilities remain with the competitor at all times. Completion of the Official Entry Form or having a motorcycle placed on display indicates that you have read and understood the terms and conditions and that you unconditionally accept them.
